

Some of her favorite roles include: *Catherine Hiatt* - *The Last Five Years*, *Mrs. Chevelly* – *An Ideal Husband*, *Katherina* in *Taming of the Shrew* (*Gallery Theatre*); *Beggar Woman* - *Sweeney Todd* (*Fullerton College*); *Titania* - *A Midsummer Night's Dream* (*Mysterium Theatre*); *Carrie Pipperidge* - *Carousel* (*OCHSA*); *Mrs. MacAfee* - *Bye, Bye Birdie* (*MTOC*); *Ophelia* - *Hamlet* (*AFAS*); *April* - *Company*, *Jenny* - *Shape of Things* (*Hunger Artists*).

In Lauren's junior year of high school, she was nominated for a Cappie award for her choreography in a student-led production of Pinocchio. Once in college, Lauren began to branch out in her performance styles, eventually picking up most swing, latin, and ballroom styles. She returned to OCCT as an assistant choreographer for Cinderella (also under the direction of Kaitlyn Tice) and her high school, BCHS, to choreograph the shows Music Man, Godspell, and Sound of Music. In summer of 2013, Lauren spent time training with the Radio City Rockettes in pursuit of her performing career, and later returned to audition for the company, making it past several rounds of auditions. Lauren graduated from CSULB with her BA in Liberal Studies/Special Education and now works as a choreographer, model, and behavior interventionist with an ABA company in Huntington Beach. Lauren continues to train weekly at Atomic Ballroom in Irvine, practicing her ballroom, latin, and swing dancing and has thoroughly enjoyed incorporating all her dance styles into this show.
