Bethany Price - Director

Bethany is so happy to return to OCCT and to work with some of her favorite young performers and their families, after her exciting and satisfying OCCT directorial debut with Sound of Music. During her more than 35 years in theatre, she has stage managed, directed, written and/or produced approximately 60 shows, and was herself a performer for more than 15 years. Bethany received her theatrical training at California State University, Long Beach, where she was a founding member of California Repertory Company. She is the mother of three children, and has more than 20 years experience casting, coaching, and directing school-age kids in stage productions. In recent years, she directed productions of Alice in Wonderland, The Jungle Book, Seussical! And her own stage adaptation of The Velveteen Rabbit, with music by Erik Przytulski. In 2011 and 2012 she wrote, produced and directed two original musicals – The Kingdom that Couldn't Sleep

and Adventure!: The Musical, both of which featured music and lyrics by Erik Przytulski. Bethany combines her love of theatre with her fondness for teaching and children with her company, Take the Stage Long Beach, an acting training program for actors ages 4-18.



Jenny Moon Shaw - Choreographer

Jenny is so happy to be back with OCCT! She moved to America less than three years ago and is glad to have found a new home in Californian theatre. Jenny was also Director of Performing Arts at a High School in England. This is her seventh choreography project in America. Art Ortiz - Vocal Director

Art has enjoyed his third year working with the talented youth of OCCT, Joseph and the Technicolor Dream Coat, The Sound of Music and this performance of The Music Man.

Art Ortiz has 21 years of experience traveling as a full-time Christian recording artist and evangelist in over 4000 performances. He has a Bachelor of Arts degree in Vocal Performance and Music Education from Azusa Pacific University. Moreover, he has produced, choreographed, and directed over 50 drama and musical productions. He is an award winning soloist, composer, and a gifted pianist, with over 100 private vocal and piano students. A well-respected teacher/director for 6 years at Arts and Learning Conservatory, as well as presently and formerly a teacher for Takelessons.com, WyzAnt.com, Virtuoso Music, Music

Theater of Orange County, Virtuosos Russian Music Academy, Shoreline Academy of the Arts, and Jubilate Academy. He is also the youth pastor for The Lord's Church. Notably, he is a recording artist in his own right with 10 recordings, traveling across country nationally and in 13 countries internationally.



Cynthia Price – Assistant Choreographer

Cynthia Price has been acting, singing, and dancing since she was 3 years old. Most of her work in theatre has been on stage, with performances in such shows "Sweeney Todd" and "Seussical," "Class of '90" and "Marriage of Figaro." She is currently a parade performer in the Pixar Parade at Disney's California Adventure. Favorite theatrical experiences include performing in the ensemble of 3-D Theatricals' "Wizard of Oz," as a child soloist in "The Glory of Christmas" at the Crystal Cathedral, and as Fredrika in Sondheim's "A Little Night Music." She is the 2014-2015 recipient of the Lana Alper Scholarship for Musical Theatre.
